DATA PROTECTION AND PRIVACY

POLICY

The Committee of the Wye Valley Retriever Club is committed to ensuring that personal information is handled in a secure and confidential manner in accordance with its obligations under the Data Protection Act 2018ⁱ.

The Committee will assign roles and responsibilities for controlling data and will implement procedures which define what data is held by the Committee, how it is controlled and processed, and how the rights of data subjects are upheld.

The Committee officers process personal data in order to manage the activities of the Club.

PERSONAL DATA HELD BY THE CLUB

- For each Club member, the Club will hold personal data including name, address, phone numbers, email addresses.
- For individuals who are associated with the Club's activities, such as Working Test Judges, Field Trial Judges, trainers, landowners, the Club will hold personal data including name, address, phone numbers, email address, qualifications.
- The Club may hold photographs of Club members, judges etc taken during the Club's activities.

WHY THE CLUB HOLDS YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We hold personal data in order to maintain the Club's records of membership, to communicate information about the Club's activities, to make arrangements for the Club's activities, and to manage compliance with the Club's Rules and Regulations.
