Only one dog per handler in a class. You must be a member of the Club. Please copy the form if you are applying for more than two dogs. **One cheque of £60 per dog please. Two dogs means two cheques! Please do not add anything else (like membership fees) to your training cheque(s)**

Assessment - Saturday 16th April 2022. Training – Tuesday evenings, 26th April to 14th June 2022 (8 week course).

Attendance at the Assessment is compulsory. This is to enable us to get the right dogs in the right groups and ensure the minimum requirements are met (see below).

Taking part in the training qualifies that dog to attend the End of Term Test/Fun Day on Saturday 16th July.

Dummy throwers – We cannot run our classes properly without dummy throwers. If you can commit to throwing dummies for the whole 8 week course, you qualify to have one dog attend another class free of charge. Please let Jean know when you send in this form. You will need to attend the Assessment day. In the unlikely event we are over-run with offers (in total or for any one time slot), this offer may be subject to availability!!

Minimum Requirements all ages – We recommend taking dogs to obedience classes to get the essentials before they are brought to gundog training.

Politeness to our Landowners – Attending our training is conditional upon observing all the requirements of our landowners. Only the specified entrance/exit may be used. Attendees may not exercise their dogs except in the designated areas. Dogs must be on a lead at all times except when in class. **Please pick up after your dog and take it home!**
