Only one dog per handler in a class. You must be a member of the Club. Due to the timing of the classes, we are unlikely to be able to accommodate any handler wanting to train more than 2 dogs. If you apply for two dogs, please indicate which is your first preference to be trained, in case of shortage of spaces on the classes. **One cheque of £90 per dog please. Two dogs means two cheques! Please do not add anything else to your training cheque(s).** The fee covers the 7 training classes (28th April to 9th June) and the unlicenced working test with social evening (including food) on the 8th week (16th June). Dogs which have not trained with us before need to attend an **assessment evening on 14th April commencing at 6:00pm**.

If you cannot pay by cheque, please **do not** make payment direct to the club's bank account, please contact Sue at sue.hallett@me.com. You will be sent a payment link **once we have sorted out the classes**.

Politeness to our Landowners – Attending our training is conditional upon observing all the requirements of our landowners. Only the specified entrance/exit may be used.
